<u>Terms and conditions of Membership</u>	<u>About the Patterns you receive each month:</u>
<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Annual memberships after April 30, 2009 cost \$240.2. Charter membership (members before April 20th 2009) on-time renewals remain fixed at \$120.3. Your membership is activated once payment is confirmed and acknowledged by an email from Quilts etcetera to the subscribing member.4. Receipt of a confirming email means that you have accepted all terms and conditions related to membership and have agreed to become a LICENSEE (user of purchased designs) and respect all copyright laws and licensed terms of use, both of which are incorporated into the confirming email.5. Register on-line in the Etcetera Store.6. You must have a registered Etcetera Store account to purchase designs from the Etcetera Store.7. <i>Stitchin' Pal Monthly Club Sets</i> are released via email to registered club members on the first business day after the end of each month (in 2009 that means February 2, March 2, April 1, etc.).8. You must be a registered subscriber by the 15th day of each month to receive the <i>Stitchin' Pal Set</i> for that month.9. 90 day cancellation terms.10. Cancellation Policies are strictly enforced and the clock starts ticking on the cancellation period at the end of the current month regardless of whether the current design theme set has been sent.11. Sorry but we will not consider monthly membership status. It's simply too complex, requires far more administration and adds more cost than we afford to bare.	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Currently all the Stitchin' Pal designs in the monthly sets designed for Club members will be sent via email in the aforementioned formats and ready for use. You will also receive a PDF file with images of the pal design(s) for use in printing hardcopy material for catalogues and other materials helpful to both you and your customers.2. In addition you will receive a file outlining our Terms and Conditions of use and any general pattern information we feel help in making the most out of you Stitchin' Pals.3. For Club members we have decided to operate our club business on an honor system, which means:<ul style="list-style-type: none">• We trust all members will honor the designer's copyright imbedded in the file format of each of our Pal designs; the Licensed Terms of Use; and U.S. Copyright Law.• We will incorporate into the email containing the monthly <i>Stitchin' Pal Sets</i> a message restating the Terms and Conditions for Rawk Club Membership and the Licensed Terms of Use for all <i>Stitchin' Pal designs</i>.

LICENSED TERMS OF USE	
<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Stitchin'Pals—are patterns designed and copyrighted by Gary Watson of Quilts etcetera and NexTrac LLC. The official website is http://www.quiltsxcetera.com . Please address questions regarding copyright or witnessed violations of copyright to gary@quiltsxcetera.com.2. LICENSEE – The licensee of a Stitchin' Pal design by Gary Watson and/or Quilts Etcetera shall be a SINGLE INDIVIDUAL purchaser or their agent who is an actual person and not a corporate, business or organizational entity comprised of multiple users. Only the licensee is authorized to use the purchased patterns.3. The copyright notice imbedded in each copyrighted design may not legally be removed from the pattern regardless of whether or not patterns are otherwise modified.4. Patterns may be modified by the LICENSEE when quilting but only for that purpose. Notice: Patterns may not be duplicated with or without modifications and used for any other purposes than explicitly stated under licensed terms of use.5. LICENSED TERMS OF USE – Patterns may be used to quilt any number of personal objects EXCLUSIVELY by the licensee or their agent. If used in quilts or quilted items for resale, a credit for the quilting design must be given to Gary Watson or Quilts etcetera on the documentation (not necessarily on the label) displayed by the quilted item.6. LICENSEES are encouraged to use Stitchin' Pal patterns to quilt for others in a cottage industry style business which performs quilting services.	<ol style="list-style-type: none">7. The LICENSEE can use the patterns to operate up to three—total—individual computerized long arm machine quilters regardless of manufacturer.8. The LICENSEE may not put or use these patterns on a rental or leased machine that would allow anyone other than the licensee or their agent to access the patterns.9. Royalty fee based licensing of all Stitchin' Pal designs by Gary Watson for the manufacture of related goods must be arranged with Quilts etcetera or it's parent NexTrac LLC.10. All promotional displays of patterns, must reflect the copyright of the designer.11. TRANSFER OF LICENSE – No transfer of license is possible unless the original licensee is deceased, or signs an affidavit confirming that they no longer have any equipment that would allow them to use the patterns in question, and that they have/will not be purchasing any equipment that will allow them to use the patterns in the foreseeable future.
